

Ronsco scores AWCi award twice in 3 years

For the second time in three years, Ronsco, Inc. has been honored with Association of Wall and Ceiling Industry's Excellence in Construction Safety Award, a national awards program designed to provide recognition for member contractors who manage outstanding effective safety programs.

Ronsco was provided this honor in the "Fewer than 100,000 annual man-hours" category and this is the second time that Ronsco has won a safety award given by AWCi in three years. Ronsco's nationally recognized company-wide safety program has enabled the organization to reduce accidents by 80 percent and helped the organization recruit and

retain some of the most experienced craftsmen in the industry. In recognition of this commitment, Ronsco was the recipient of several recent safety awards in addition to the 2008 AWCi award, including the 2007 BTEA's Charles LaBette Safety Award, the 2006 Excellence in Construction Safety Award by the AWCi.

According to Lee Zaretsky, Principal of Ronsco, the company's commitment to safety can be summarized in three primary areas: management commitment; continuous on & off the job safety training and hazard awareness programs; and use of AWCi's eSafetyLine Web based safety software
